Some of the major benefits passed on to the Consumers are:

1. Delayed Payment Surcharge linked with Bank rate plus 500 basis points on monthly basis with increase of 50 basis points monthly subject to a maximum of yearly 700 basis points.
2. Fixed Charge recovery linked to nos. of hours of supply. For HT consumers- 23 Hours and LT Consumers -21 Hours for recovery of full fixed charge.
3. Prompt payment rebate of 2% on bill value (Capacity Charges and Energy Charges) for payment within 5 days of the presentation of bills.
4. Due date for payment will be 15 days for LT domestic, Commercial and Agricultural consumers and 21 days will be for all other Consumers.

5. Additional 1% rebate shall be for payment within due date on entire billed amount made either through online or any digital mode subject to a maximum ceiling of Rs. 250 against the billed amount.
6. Rebate of 3% on Energy charges for switching to pre-paid metering.
7. Rebate at the rate of 1% on bill amount per month for delay beyond two months or part thereof shall be applicable subject to a ceiling of 3%.
8. Voltage Rebate: Applicable on Energy charges as per the JSERC (Electricity Supply Code) Regulations, 2015 for HTS/HT-Institutional (33 kV): 3%, HTS/HT-Institutional (132 kV): 5%, HTS/HT-Institutional (220 kV): 5.5%, HTS/HT-Institutional (220 kV): 6%
9. Load Factor Rebate: For every 1% increase in Load Factor above 65%, 1 % rebate will be allowed to HT consumers on total energy charges corresponding to total energy consumption subject to the ceiling of 15%.
10. ToD tariff as an option to HTS and HT Institutional consumers
11. Attractive Gross/Net metering tariff retained for promotion of Renewable energy.

The details regarding the applicability of the above listed rebates are mentioned in the Tariff order for FY 2021-22 issued by the Commission on January 30, 2023.
